We invite your class to an educational, fun-filled, self-guided, “*at your own pace*” visit to our family farm **Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays**, 10am until 2pm starting Sept. 28th through Oct. 28th! Learn Where Food Comes From! Features and attractions of your visit are:

- Educational Wall – Educational boards filled with fun facts about farm animals, crops, and farm life that are sure to delight and inform your students!
- A wagon ride through a real pumpkin field (weather permitting).
- Farm Animal Area – Everyone receives a cone of feed for the sheep and goats! Watch the goats walk on the roof! Maybe you'll see some new baby goats, piglets, and a calf too!
- Check out the Baby Chick House for the newest arrivals!
- Students get great exercise in all of our 5 play areas. Climb aboard the Pirate Ship in Port Cottonwood. Play in the “kid sized” barns and silo in Barnyard Playland! Play on the 48 foot long Train or sit in the New Frank's Flyer Airplane in the Wheels of Fun playland! Explore the elevated Bird Houses and Bridges in Kaden's Birdie Barracks! Visit Maddie's Mansion, Chalet & Schoolhouse Playland!
- Students will climb aboard to ride the Ghost Town Railroad!
- Both Adults and Kids of any age will enjoy our Jumping Pillows!
- October is National Bullying Prevention Month so students can walk through Spookley's Special 20th Birthday Corn Maze telling Spookley's unique story of kindness and tolerance!
- Free use of our covered picnic area for your snack / lunch. Space must be reserved when you schedule your visit. *Space is limited

- Visit Kyle's Corn Crib Café for Coffee, Hot Cider, Fountain Drinks, Hot Dogs, Pizza and more! Our Donut Depot has Fresh Hot Apple Cider Donuts, Hot Apple Cider and Coffee!
- A free kid-sized pumpkin for each paid guest as you exit (Please bring your own bag).

This fun-filled educational visit to our farm is available for \$12.00 per student & chaperones. (*Coupons cannot be used and “two and under free” does not apply to school group visits!*)

Students can visit our Gem Mine and take home the treasures they discover in the “bag of gems” they pan through in our water sluice. Each bag is \$5.00. **In order to guarantee your tour date we require a \$100.00 non-refundable deposit per class within 7 days.** The deposit will be deducted from the total due on the day of your visit. Each year we sell out a bit earlier, so call today to reserve! All reservations are taken on a first come – first served basis. **Note: All payments are due on arrival the day of your visit. We will collect and store your lunches upon arrival.** We recommend putting the students' names on the lunch bags.

To start your visit, upon arrival, please have the following ready before you exit your bus:

- 1) Your payment in cash, school check, or credit card.
- 2) The separate totals of students, teachers, and chaperones in your group.
- 3) If your group is arriving in separate cars, please gather as a single group. Have all monies collected by a teacher before entering.
